Museum Director's Report

Ms. Mundy stated 1,900 people visited since the last meeting. 100 children participated in the museum's summer series, Tuesdays at 2 where participants learned about art and nature in activities led by the Shelby East Garden Club and the Memphis Botanic Garden.

Ms. Mundy announces that the Fall Lunch n' Learn schedule is out. She states that the fall lectures will focus on the Civil War. The first lecture will be by Shelby County Historian, Jimmy Ogle.

Ms. Mundy stated that August 13th will be the Museum's Spotlight Saturday, which will be the museum's annual Train Heritage Day. She states that this will be the 3rd Train Heritage Day and that there will be several local train groups in attendance.

Ms. Mundy stated that the museum is preparing a new exhibit on the history of the Collierville Fire Department that will open September 10th and will be on view through October. The museum is working with Erin Daniels, Public Education Coordinator for the CFD, on the project.

Mr. Clayton asked with Dairy Day will be. Ms. Mundy reported that this year's Dairy Day will be held on Saturday, October 22nd.

Ms. Mundy presented a donation from Mrs. Michele Hyduke of two prints of the town square gazebo.


Mr. Shepherd states that there is a good military history museum in Halls, Tennessee.
