

A regular meeting of the Collierville Heritage Commission was held November 9th, 2016 at 2:30pm at the Morton Museum 196 N. Main Street, Collierville, Tennessee

Ms. Mundy announced that 40 students participated in the museum's Dairy Making workshop on October 14th. 450 guests attended the museum's annual Dairy Day event on October 22nd, 2016.

Ms. Mundy stated that Steve Cole gave a lecture on Thursday, October 27th on Forrest's Cattle Raid campaign.

Ms. Mundy reported the following upcoming events:

Fall Into Art is coming up on Saturday, November 12th to celebrate the museum's 2016 community artists and open the 2016 retrospective exhibit. Artists will be on site creating art in and around the museum.

Jimmy Ogle will speak on December 1st at 11:00am in anticipation of the Collierville Home Tour.

Santa will be at the museum on December 2nd for Story Time.


The museum's annual holiday program will be December 3rd and will feature a special performance by Iris Orchestra.

Mr. Clayton made a motion to accept the painting. Mrs. Edmunds seconded. The motion is approved.


The next meeting will be held January 11th, 2016 at 2:30pm at the Morton Museum.
