### **Revision to** **Storm Water Ordinance** **Construction Exit Requirements**

Effective August 1, 2006, The Town of Collierville implemented an additional requirement for providing Construction Exits from construction sites.

A Construction Exit is defined as a stone-stabilized pad located at any point where vehicular traffic will be leaving a construction site.

The purpose of the Construction Exit is to help reduce or eliminate the transport of sedimentation and silt from the construction area onto a public roadway.

Construction Exits should be made of non-erodible material, typically rock or gravel with a minimum bed thickness of 6”.

The width and length of the Construction Exit is required to be approximately 10' x 20'.

The Construction Exit is required to be maintained in a condition that will prevent tracking or flow of material onto the public right-of-way.

Any materials tracked from the site onto roadways must be removed immediately.
