OTHER BUSINESS


Update on the Farms at Bailey Station bond request

Mr. Duncan stated that the representatives from Retirement Companies of America (RCA) were still working to deliver answers to the Board's questions.


Brief discussion ensued regarding positive growth in Collierville.
